CHG TO READ - ....elected yearly for a term of 6 years

RULES be amended to include Section (v) to read as follows: The Dist Lodge shall maintain a Hall of Fame to recognize those worthy members who have devoted their time and energies to the betterment of VASA. The local lodges may select a nominee and submit to the Exec. Bd. The nominee will be honored with a plaque and Cert. of Appreciation...
