From the Cultural Committee



The following is a summary of the program presented at the March meeting on Swedish musician/composer Gunnar De Frumerie.

GUNNAR DE FRUMERIE

Among the leading Swedish composers of the 1930's, which included Lars-Eric Larsson, Dag Wiren and Hugo Alfven, Gunnar De Frumerie was born in 1908 and died in 1987.

De Frumerie displayed an early aptitude as a pianist. With a career as a concert pianist and professor of piano for most of his life, he performed many musical compositions such as grand opera, orchestral works and piano concertos.

Although De Frumerie has been grouped with Lars Eric Larsson, Dag Wiren and Hugo Alfven, he differs from them by daring to display a *Romantic Disposition, a Rich Sound and Emotional Musical Language*.

His best known work is his *Pastoral Suite* for flute, orchestra and harp. He wrote this in 1933, originally for only flute and piano. Later in 1941, he prepared the version for orchestra with the flute and harp.

This music is a "suite." A *suite* in music is a group of songs grouped and played together. In the Pastoral Suite, there are five songs:

1. Preludium; 2. Govotte; 3. Saraband; 4. Siciliano; and 5. Final If any of you are interested in obtaining this music on CD, you can order it at any *Borders* store. The album features music of four other Swedish composers, played by the Swedish Chamber Orchestra. The title is: *Swedish Orchestral Favourites, Vol. 2.* It is on a NAXOS label, #8.553715.
