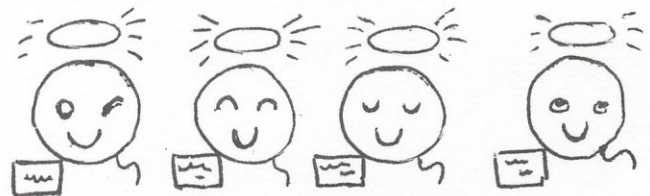
Tickets! Tickets! Tickets! Tickets!
