How to reach Sveadal

From north and south. Travel on 101 to BAILEY Road, one mile south of the little town of Coyote. Cross railroad tracks and go Bailey to the end. Turn left into McKean Road. Follow McKean Road — here also called Uvas Road — to Croy Road. Turn right into Croy Road and follow Croy to Sveadal. Look for blue-yellow streamers or other signs from Bailey Road.
