Nine new members were initiated last meeting. Due to lack of space in this issue I will include their names & addresses next month. Welcome to Monitor Lodge.

The following resolutions will be considered at District Convention in Reno. (April 24-26)

<u>Res. 1</u> Forming a District Honorary Life Membership in District Lodge that would give recipient the right of speech and vote at every convention he attends for life just as an elected delegate has, and with District paying all dues and fees for said Honorary Life Member for remaining lifetime. Sets up requirements and procedures for doing this in District. There is no mention of Honorary District Life Membership in our constitution and By-Laws at this time.

<u>Res.</u> 2 Suggests changing District Convention from every year last week in April to every <u>other</u> year on last weekend in April. Purpose suggested was cutting costs to host lodges, giving District Master two years to cover his official visits, and spreads duties of District Secretary load over a two year period.

<u>Res.</u> 3 Suggests limiting elected District Officers to: District Master, Vice District Master, District Secretary, District Treasurer, Treasurer of District Sick Benefit Fund, and District Cultural Leader. All other District officers, whose duties are ritualistic in nature and called upon only at convention be <u>appointed</u> from existing and attending delegates at the convention. It is thought this would greatly shorten the election procedure and the meeting.

<u>Res. 4</u> Suggests <u>paying</u> District and local lodge Children's Club supervisors from the existing District Children's Club Fund upon receipt and acceptance of their annual reports. The Grand Lodge does this.
