

THREE "Bs" - BERNADOTTE, BANER, AND BERZELIUS

The Swedish Trivia quiz in the Vasa Star asked for three famous Swedes whose names began with "B". That was fairly easy. Most of us can think of Bjorn Bjorg of tennis fame; Bergman, either Ingmar or Ingrid of the films, and possibly of Jussi Bjoerling of opera fame. The Vasa Star came up with the first two of these but also Karl Bellman (1740-1795). Bellman was the Swedish song writer who was a favorite of Gustaf III. His songs are still known in Sweden but he is hardly known elsewhere.

My own first choice was King Carl XVI Gustaf Bernadotte. Although the name was originally French, there have been five generations of Swedish born kings of that family since Carl XV who became king in 1859. It has been said that the Swedish royal family does not have a drop of Swedish blood since the royal princes married foreign princess'. Swedish birth should make Carl Gustaf sufficiently Swedish.

My second choice was Johan Baner (1596-1641). During the Thirty Years War he served as chief of staff to Gustaf II Adolf, and eventually succeeded him in command of the Swedish Army in Germany after the death of Gustaf. As Field Marshal, he was able to organize the polyglot army of Swedish, German, and French troops and Scottish mercenaries into an effective mobile and victorious fighting force.

My third selection is Jons Jacob Berzelius (1779-1848), the Swedish chemist who is regarded as the founder of modern chemistry. Every chemistry student who uses the symbols for the elements is making use of Berzelius' work. He is the one who devised these convenient symbols that make it possible to express chemical formulas in simple form. And that was only one of his many contributions.


