#### Status report regarding scanning of various Monitor documents for posterity.

- Newsletters we have scanned all our newsletters from 1971 to the present in searchable PDF format. We have posted back issues from January 2018 onward on our <u>newsletters</u> web page. Should you find any newsletters, especially pre-1971, please let us scan them for inclusion in our collection. Copies of these digital files are stored at Bishop Hill.
- Meeting minutes 1937-1982 are in JPG format (not searchable) and are not online on our website. We currently have one copy of the DVD in the Chairman's file box plus a copy on Chuck Johnson's computer. All these minutes are handwritten and the pre-1941 copies are in Swedish. The original microfiche, DVD and paper copies are also stored at Bishop Hill along with some pre-1937 documents and minutes that are not in digital format and which Monitor does not have copies in its possession locally.
   1983-1990 we are still seeking copies for scanning.
  - <u>1991-2000</u> we just finished scanning. These were typed and have been scanned into searchable PDF format. It appears from reading the 1991-2000 minutes that most of the paper minutes were preserved but we are still missing all of 1992 (except January). We will be forwarding copies of these scanned files to Bishop Hill soon.
  - <u>2001-2015</u> We have only found 5 meeting minutes for these 15 years. These are critical years for helping us reconstruct our official local governing documents.
